All estimate requests must be made by completing this form in its entirety and mailed to MPERS at the address stated above or faxed to (225)929-6542. Members can obtain one free estimate per year. Any additional estimates within 12 months of your last estimate will incur a \$25 fee due with request (make checks payable to MPERS). Please allow 2-4 weeks for estimate.

Duty Related Non-Duty Related

In order for you to apply for disability benefits, the injury or illness must be to the extent that you are totally and permanently disabled from performing your job duties. Disability claims will not be honored in the case of preexisting conditions. If you were previously a member of this system and refunded your contributions, you must repay your refunded contributions plus interest prior to submitting your application for approval regardless of whether or not the disability is non-duty-related or duty related.

Members prior to January 1, 2013 - Benefit is based on 3% accrual rate no less than 40% no more than 60% of average final compensation. A minimum of 10 years of service credit is required for a non-duty-related disability. A duty-related disability does not require a minimum amount of service credit, however, the injury or illness must have been incurred after becoming a member of this system to be considered duty-related.

Hazardous Duty Members on or after January 1, 2013 - Benefit is based on 2.75% accrual rate no less than 33% no more than 55% of average final compensation, must have 10 years of service, unless in line of duty. A duty-related disability does not require a minimum amount of service credit, however, the injury or illness must have been incurred after becoming a member of this system to be considered duty related.

Non-Hazardous Duty Members on or after January 1, 2013 - Benefit is based on 2.25% accrual rate no less than 25% no more than 50% of average final compensation, must have a minimum of 10 years service regardless of in line of duty.

The average processing time is 60-90 days from the date the completed application and all required medical records are received by MPERS.
